Content:

The written assignment entails an information sheet on a childhood or adolescent disorder of your choice. You must choose from the disorders covered in this course. The information sheet is aimed at parents and caregivers whose child has received a diagnosis. However, as this is still an academic exercise, you must still cite your sources and include a reference list in APA style.

The information sheet is based on a literature review and should include the following:

- a) A description of the symptoms of the disorder and related diagnostic criteria
- b) A discussion of the possible causes of the disorder
 - o This should include at least two major theories which should be described in detail
 - These theories should be supported by research evidence
- c) A critical analysis of available treatments and the strength of supporting evidence
 - This should include at least two evidence-based treatments.
 - Supporting evidence should not be presented as descriptions of studies, rather:
 - i. Supporting evidence should be presented as a synthesis of evidence
 - Supporting evidence should also be presented with an analysis of its overall quality
 - Please note you are not required to describe or understand the treatment (no description is required, see the grading matrix), rather you are required to demonstrate an ability to <u>critically analyse the evidence for the treatments</u>
