# When cigarettes first started being made

Washington Duke invented the first

commercial cigarette in 1865. This

happened on his farm, 300 acres, which lies

in Raleigh in North California. Duke rolled

the cigarettes by use of his hands and

commercialized it to the soldiers at the end

of the Civil War.



### **Cigarette Machine**

By 1800s, a vast number of Americans were using

Tobacco by chewing and smoking through pipes.

This is where cigarettes were through hand rolling

("history of cigarettes - Google Search," 2019).

This encouraged James Bonsack to introduce the

first machine for making cigarettes in 1881. This

led to the spread and rapid increase of cigarette

smoking and formation incidences because the

device could produce about 120,000 cigarettes in

one day.



#### **Duke's son and Bonsacks deal**

Bonsack resolved to strike a business deal with Washington Duke's son and built a factory specifically for manufacturing cigarettes. In the first year of the factory's business, Duke's son and Bonsack produced about 10 million commercial cigarettes which gave an estimate of one billion commercial cigarettes in five years (Enstad, 2018). This Company remained the best cigarette producer in America until the early 1900s ("history of cigarettes - Google Search," 2019). Several companies came into the market and by 1902; Philip Morris's company developed its brand called Malboro. Marlboro is the most popular cigarette brand in the United States, with sales greater than the next seven leading competitors combined.



#### Why were Cigarettes made ?

The American colony who settled in

Jamestown in Virginia produced Tobacco as a

cash crop, that is in 1612. The money earned

from selling Tobacco was then used to pay for

the Revolution between Americans and

England. Specifically, cigarettes were invented

for monetary purposes ("Why were cigarettes

invented? - Quora", 2019).



# Growth of cigarette productions and sales

By 1944, production of cigarettes had grown to 300 billion productions per year out of which the

servicemen were given 75% of the total amount of cigarettes produced ("history of cigarettes - Google

Search," 2019). World War II was good for the Cigarette industry because it was after the war that six giant cigarette companies came into existence.

# **Electronic Cigarettes**

producing smoke. In other words, it is a system which


electronically delivers nicotine.
