Ethnic Restaurant Assignment

Assignment Description

The purpose of this assignment is to introduce you to a new cultural food experience. As part of the assignment you will visit an ethnic restaurant serving food of a culture that you have never experienced before.

Traditionally for this assignment you would visit an ethnic food restaurant of a culture that you have never experienced before.

Given the limitations of this during the COVID-19 pandemic we are going to do a modified "online" experience exploring an ethnic food restaurant of your choice.

For this assignment you will need to:

- Pick a food culture whose restaurant you have never eaten at or cuisine you have never tried
 - You can search the list at the end of this assignment or use your book for food culture inspiration
- Identify which food culture you are exploring and then search online for videos, articles, images of that food culture and what their restaurant or dining experience appears to be like
 - Example, search YouTube for "Ethiopian restaurant"
 - \circ $\;$ You can explore an ethnic restaurant based in the US or the store in its country or area of origin
 - You can also choose to reflect on a home-based meal experience of a new food culture instead of commercial restaurant if you prefer
- Find at least 3 resources you include in your review and include them in your reflection paper writeup

If you have eaten Mexican food before...you can't review a Mexican restaurant. If you have had sushi before...you can't review a sushi restaurant. Please use this assignment as an opportunity to expand your cultural foods horizons and to patronize some of the vast variety of ethnic food offerings our region has to showcase.

Alternatively, if you can find an ethnic restaurant of a new food culture that is open and in line with your current comfort level of dining, you are welcome to complete this assignment by eating at the new food culture's restaurant. In pre-COVID times this was the requirement of this assignment and in lieu of references please include a screenshot or photo of your receipt to prove your attendance.

Deliverables

For this experience you will need to write a two-to-three page paper reflecting on how this experience enhanced your awareness of the interconnectedness and diversity of the food culture.

All papers must be word-processed, double-spaced, Times New Roman and 10-12 point size font with one-inch margins. You will upload your paper to Blackboard. The assignment is worth 10 points.

You need to include your 3 references cited in your paper using either MLA or APA citation style.

Grading Rubric

This assignment is worth 10 points:

- 8 points for style and content
- 2 points for appropriate punctuation and grammar

All papers must be submitted in either .doc, .docx or .pdf formats to be graded.

Please see the course syllabus for the due date and time. Note that no late work will be accepted and there is no partial credit given.

Questions and Inclusions to Consider for Your Reflection Paper

- Name and address of the restaurant, what neighborhood is it in?
- What ethnic group or country(ies) is/are represented?
- Describe the setting: booth, tables, pictures, shrines, carpet, type of floor, bar, smell, lighting?
- What was at your table: condiments, paper or cloth linens, describe items, colors?
- Look at the menu and decipher it: are items a la carte, vegetarian, alcoholic, family-style?
- Talk to the staff: what do they recommend, what is house or nationality specialty? Did you
 get what was recommended? Why or why not? Could you see the people prepare the food?
- Your opinion of the food: did you like what you ordered? What were the flavors you could identify? Did you share with others? Was it what you would consider to be a good value?
- Impressions on food safety: any hygiene or sanitation concerns? Similar to or different from other places where you usually dine?
- Include anything else about your experience that you want to report.
- Why did you choose this restaurant? Who did you go with? Would you go back, why or why not?
- What did you learn from this experience?
