Nurse educators teach, inspire, and mentor the future generation of nurse, fostering the future care delivery. The best nurse educator has a spirit of inquiry, taking time to invest in teams at a personal level. They collaborate with colleagues and other staff to evaluate nurse student's capabilities through gathering of information. According to Lynch (2015), "a spirit of inquiry is an integral part of the role, and outstanding nurse educators." They gather information about the students through direct observations, which enables them to provide feedback on areas that require improvement in nursing field. There are various significant areas nurse educators often evaluate, including applying person-centered care, follow-up on nursing intervention, accurate documentation of medical history, diagnosis, status, interventions, and summary of care (Global Health, 2020). Moreover, nurse educators often support professional development of their peers, such as educational seminars for colleagues and nursing staff, and arranging team-building programs.

The Tripartite Model

The tripartite role is behavioral repertoire reflecting conditions and tasks, including teaching, scholarship, and collaboration. Nurse educators are often knowledgeable and well-educated and possess excellent communication skills and clinical experience. Teaching nursing students requires foundational knowledge and experience in science and art, testing and evaluation methods, and educational theories. Lifelong research and active scholarship foster a spirit of inquiry to broaden one's perspectives through independent study (Cash & Tate, 2012). Through scholarships, nurse educators can build a critical understanding of health issues, trends, and problems. Likewise, nurse educator's services must adhere to a nursing ideology, particularly professional values, such as AACN (the American Association of Colleges of Nursing). These professional values include autonomy, integrity, human dignity, caring, altruism, social justice, and life-long learning.

Unfortunately, you earned a grade level of basic on the paper. There are some excellent points in your work but some areas could be clearer with additional detail and explanation. You needed to clearly identify the role you want to pursue in education, define and analyze activities to meet the three tripartite roles (by name), and generate **your personal** plan to achieve these based on your desired role. You then needed to focus on scholarship activities specific to your role, and demonstrate how you will become a change agent.
